The Contract

HogParking, LLC

The contract for parking/tailgating spots is a unilateral contract. This means that you must perform completely by submitting a valid payment before HogParking, LLC must reserve a spot for you. You can only accept this offer for a tailgating or parking spot by acting fully and completely by submitting a valid payment. A promise to pay will not suffice. We usually mail out your parking/tailgating pass the day we receive your payment. HogParking, LLC does not warrant the quality of the spot, but we do assure you that we will do everything commercially practical and possible to ensure a comfortable and safe game-day experience for each of our quests.

Ice, cable TV access, and Wi-Fi are all available on a complementary basis and on a first-come, first-served basis. As with all free services, their availability can be exhausted. Tiled, public restrooms are provided. However, lines do form; don't wait until the last minute.

When you purchase a reserve spot or a general admission spot, we will provide you with a space of 10 feet x 10 feet. Some of our spaces may be larger than this, but we are obligated by this agreement to provide only a 10' x 10' space.

On Game Day

We do not assume the risk of damage or conversion of any of your property. Our staff is on duty before, during and after the game. We will keep an eye out for any suspicious activity, but we cannot assume the risk of loss or damage to your property. Accordingly, we do not assume any risk associated with your property.

Also, after the game is over and your tailgate has ended, you agree to take your "things" (ice chests, tents, chairs, tables, grills, cookers, electronics, etc) home with you. Anything left on our premises after 6pm the day after the game (usually Sunday) will become the property of HogParking, LLC. It will be disposed of at our discretion. Please take anything that you own of value before this 6pm deadline.

Next Year

When you purchase a reserved spot for the current year, HogParking, LLC will grant a first-right-of-refusal for the following year, but only up to and including the last day of March of the following year. This means that you have the exclusive right to renew your spot until midnight, March 31 of the following year. After this time, you can still renew, but you run the risk that someone else may purchase "your" spot. In other words, if you enjoyed your HogPaking experience this year, you should renew your spot by the end of March for the following year to ensure its availability. Of course, this is a deadline statement. You can always renew at anytime before March 31.

Order of Priority: First in Time, First in Right.

After March 31 of the following year, more than one person or group may desire to purchase a particular spot. In this case, the person or group that paid for the following year first in time, will also be first in right to purchase the particular spot. In other words, to get the best priority, you should renew as early as possible or purchase as early as possible, if you are new to our tailgating operation. Alternatively, you may want to purchase two years in advance.
